## What should I wear?



**Do bring a waterproof jacket.**

Remember, the weather can change suddenly, a waterproof jacket will help to keep you dry and warm.

**Do wear layers of clothes and bring an extra **fleece** or **jumper**.**

**Do wear trousers but not wide bottom flares or shorts.**

*It's not cool to have farmyard muck on your trousers or legs!*

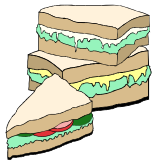
**Don't wear your best clothes. You will probably get dirty.**

**Do bring 2 pairs of shoes or boots with you.**



You will need wellies, boots or old trainers for field work and a pair of clean shoes to put on afterwards.

## What should I bring?



**Do bring your lunch and a drink.**



**Do bring a plastic bag to put your dirty shoes in.**



**Do bring a pencil to write with and a camera if you wish to.**



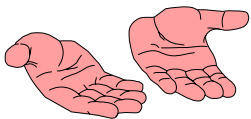
**Don't** bring lots of money. There are no shops here. **Don't** use a mobile phone or personal stereo.



## On the day



**Do not** eat food except in the Schools' Centre classroom or picnic area. You **must** wash your hands with soap and warm water before eating.



**Do Remember...** Bacteria that can cause serious illnesses can sometimes be found on farms (eg. e-coli, tetanus, salmonella). It is essential that you wear the correct clothes and footwear and wash your hands properly when asked to do so. Stay safe and healthy on your visit!

**Please listen to all instructions given by staff - this is for YOUR safety. Sparsholt is a working farm. Animals, machinery and water are dangerous if not approached correctly.**
